

Instructions for Completing Label

1. A provision in the IATA DGR allows small quantities of some dangerous goods to be shipped as "dangerous goods in excepted quantities." This provision may be useful for ethanol and formalin (10% formaldehyde) when shipping less than 30 ml per primary, 1L total. NOTE: Infectious substances are **not** included in this provision.
2. Do not use this label unless you have reviewed the OSEH Guidance Document for Shipping with Chemical Preservatives. Please contact OSEH at (763-6973) if you have any questions on the specific requirements that pertain to excepted quantities.
3. A color printer is required to produce the red hatched border. Consider printing onto an adhesive backed label. The minimum size requirement is 100 mm by 100 mm.
4. Place the cursor in the appropriate box and type in the information.
5. Select the appropriate Class by placing the cursor on the correct number and clicking.
6. Enter the UN number.
7. Sign your name after printing the label.
